LETTER DATED 9 AUGUST 1978 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I. OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF COLOMBIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to refer to Your Excellency's note PO 230 SOAF (2-2-5) dated 18 May 1978, regarding paragraph 3 of resolution 418 (1977), adopted unanimously by the Security Council on 4 November 1977 on the question of South Africa.

I wish to state that Colombia does not have any arms or munitions industry for export purposes and that the Government of Colombia complies with all United Nations resolutions establishing sanctions against South Africa because of its apartheid policy.

I have the honour to request that this letter be circulated as a document of the Security Council.
