LETTER DATED 17 MARCH 1978 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF
ISRAEL TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE
SECURITY COUNCIL

On instructions of my Government and further to my letter of 13 March 1978 (A/33/64-S/12598), I have the honour to request you to convene a meeting of the Security Council to consider the continuous acts of terror and violence against Israeli civilians, together with the frequent shelling, sabotage incursions, bombing and murder being perpetrated from Lebanese territory against Israel, its people and property, in flagrant violation of international law and the Charter of the United Nations, and with the declared intention of throwing into jeopardy the negotiations aimed at achieving a final peace agreement between Israel and its Arab neighbours.
