NOTE VERBALE DATED 20 MARCH 1978 FROM THE PERMANENT
REPRESENTATIVE OF SPAIN TO THE UNITED NATIONS
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Spain to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to refer to the letter from the Secretary-General dated 10 November 1977 transmitting the text of resolution 418 (1977) relating to the question of South Africa, which was adopted by the Security Council on 4 November 1977.

This communication merits the closest attention of the Spanish authorities. They intend to ensure the strict application of resolution 418 (1977), which will accordingly guide the formulation of Spain's policy with regard to the question of South Africa.

The Permanent Representative of Spain would be grateful if the Secretary-General would arrange for the circulation of this note as a document of the Security Council.
