NOTE VERBALE DATED 28 MARCH 1978 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF GREECE TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Greece to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to refer to His Excellency's letter dated 10 November 1977, concerning the implementation of Security Council resolution 418 (1977) adopted on 4 November 1977.

Greece, having consistently condemned the policies of apartheid and racial discrimination, as was highlighted during the discussions of the question of South Africa in the United Nations, fully supports the provisions of Security Council resolution 418 (1977) and is taking all necessary measures for its strict implementation.

The Permanent Representative of Greece would be grateful if the Secretary-General could arrange for the circulation of this note as a document of the Security Council.
