NOTE VERBALE DATED 6 APRIL 1978 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF MONGOLIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of the Mongolian People's Republic to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the Organization and in reply to his note No. PO 230 SOAF of 10 November 1977 has the honour to inform him of the following:

The Mongolian People's Republic has not had and does not have any relations with the racist régime of Pretoria.

The Mongolian People's Republic has always advocated and continues to advocate the speedy elimination of the shameful system of <u>apartheid</u> and has whole-heartedly supported the oppressed peoples of South Africa who are struggling to abolish the last hotbeds of colonialism and racism.

On the basis of this position of principle, the Mongolian People's Republic fully supports the decision of the Security Council contained in resolution 418 (1977) of 4 November 1977.

The Permanent Mission of the Mongolian People's Republic to the United Nations requests that this note verbale be issued as a Security Council document.
