The Security Council continued its consideration of the item at its 2096th and 2097th meetings, held on 6 and 10 November 1978.

At the Council's 2097th meeting, the representative of India introduced a draft resolution (S/12922) sponsored by Gabon, India, Kuwait and Nigeria.
