LETTER DATED 9 JANUARY 1978 FROM THE PERMANENT
REPRESENTATIVE OF LUXEMBOURG TO THE UNITED
NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Luxembourg to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to acknowledge receipt of note No. PO 230 SOAF OF 10 November 1977 requesting information on the action taken by the Government of Luxembourg to implement the provisions of Security Council resolution 418 (1977) of 4 November 1977.

The Permanent Representative of Luxembourg wishes to inform the Secretary-General of the United Nations herewith that his Government will give the above-mentioned resolution its full attention and will strictly comply with its obligations under resolution 418 (1977) on the mandatory arms embargo against South Africa. The Government of Luxembourg also wishes to emphasize that it has never supplied South Africa with arms and does not intend to depart from that policy in the future.

The Permanent Representative of Luxembourg to the United Nations requests that the text of this letter should be circulated as a Security Council document.
