MINISTER FOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF SAMOA ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-
GENERAL

The Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs of Samoa presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to refer to the latter's note PO 230 SOAF of 10 November 1977 concerning resolution 418 (1977) adopted unanimously by the Security Council on 4 November 1977 on "The question of South Africa".

The Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs of Samoa has further the honour to advise that Samoa has no dealings with South Africa in the field covered by the resolution and that Samoa intends to observe fully the provisions of the resolution.
