MISSION OF SAUDI ARABIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL.

The Permanent Mission of Saudi Arabia to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and with reference to His Excellency's note No. PO 230 SOAF dated 10 November 1977, concerning the implementation of Security Council resolution 418 (1977) adopted on 4 November 1977, has the honour to convey that the Government of Saudi Arabia has no relationship whatsoever with the apartheid régime in South Africa, and has never supplied nor does it intend to supply any arms to that régime.

Furthermore, the Government of Saudi Arabia would like to assure the Security Council that it will implement the provisions of resolution 418 (1977) scrupulously.

The Permanent Mission of Saudi Arabia to the United Nations has the honour to request that this communication be circulated as a document of the Security Council.
