LETTER DATED 22 FEBRUARY 1978 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF THE LIBYAN ARAB JAMAHIRIYA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO
THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

With reference to the item on the agenda of the Security Council entitled "Complaint by Chad" I have the honour to refer to my letter dated 19 February 1978 to Your Excellency circulated in document S/12568 in which I informed Your Excellency and members of the Council of the agreement between Chad, the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya and Sudan contained in the Joint Communiqué issued in Tripoli, 18 February 1978, annex I to said letter, in which Chad decided to withdraw the complaint and to work towards the re-establishment of diplomatic relations between Chad and the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya.

I have the further honour to refer to the letter of the Permanent Representative of Chad dated 21 February 1978 circulated in document S/12570 in which the Permanent Representative of Chad circulated the same Joint Communiqué in French. Taking into consideration this happy development in defusing the tension between the two neighbouring countries, I assume that the Council has taken the necessary measures to delete this item entitled "Complaint by Chad" from the list of matters of which the Security Council is seized and I would appreciate a confirmation from Your Excellency that these steps have been taken.

I should be grateful if you would circulate this letter as a document of the Security Council.
