LETTER DATED 5 APRIL 1979 FROM THE DEPUTY PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF UGANDA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to refer to my letter 5/A/l dated 28 March 1979 in which, upon instructions from my Government, I had requested for an urgent meeting of the Security Council in connexion with the question of the aggression by the United Republic of Tanzania against the Republic of Uganda.

This is to inform you that my request has been withdrawn as a result of an appeal by the African Group in New York to the Government of Uganda that the meeting not be convened at this point, the request of which was accepted by the Government of Uganda.

I would like to request that this letter be circulated as a document of the Security Council.
