NOTE VERBALE DATED 6 MARCH 1978 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF CYPRUS TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Cyprus to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to refer to the latter's note No. PO 230 of 10 November 1977 regarding resolution 418 (1977) adopted unanimously by the Security Council on 4 November 1977 on "The question of South Africa".

The Permanent Representative of Cyprus on the instructions of the Minister of Foreign Affairs wishes to inform that Cyprus does not have any arms or munitions industry and that the Government of Cyprus complies with and fully implements all United Nations resolutions establishing sanctions against South Africa.

The Permanent Representative of Cyprus to the United Nations has the honour to request that this note verbale be circulated as a document of the Security Council.
