REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The complete list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in document S/11935 of 5 January 1976 and the pertinent addenda. During the week ending 15 May 1976, the Security Council took action on the following item:

The situation in the occupied Arab territories (see S/11935/Add.18)

The Security Council continued its consideration of the item at its 1918th to 1920th meetings, held between 10 and 14 May 1976. In the course of those meetings, in addition to the representatives invited previously, the President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Kuwait, Qatar, Somalia, the Sudan and Yemen, at their request, to participate in the discussion, without the right to vote.
