SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The complete list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in document S/11935 of 5 January 1976 and the pertinent addenda. During the week ending 11 September 1976, the Security Council took action on the following item:

Admission of new Members

By a note dated 20 August 1976 (S/12183), the Secretary-General circulated the application of the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam for admission to membership in the United Nations, contained in a letter dated 20 August 1976 from the Prime Minister of the Government of the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam addressed to the Secretary-General.

The Security Council considered the application at its 1955th meeting, held on 9 September 1976.

At the 1955th meeting, the President, in accordance with the provisions of rule 59 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure and in the absence of a proposal to the contrary, referred the application of the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam to the Committee on the Admission of New Members for consideration and report.
