SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF
WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE
REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The complete list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in document S/11935 of 5 January 1976 and the pertinent addenda. During the week ending 2 October 1976, the Security Council took action on the following item:

The situation in Namibia (see S/8367, S/8424, S/8428, S/8438, S/8450, S/8468, S/9107, S/9373, S/9382, S/9395, S/9636, S/9898, S/10351, S/10369, S/10375, S/10377, S/10757, S/10770/Add.15, S/10770/Add.16, S/10855/Add.3, S/10855/Add.50, S/11185/Add.50, S/11593/Add.21, S/11593/Add.22, S/11935/Add.4 and S/11935/Add.35).

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 1956th meeting, held on 28 September 1976. The Council continued its discussion of the item at its 1957th and 1958th meetings, held on 30 September and 1 October. During the course of the meetings, the President, with the consent of the Council, renewed the Council's previous invitations to the delegation of the United Nations Council for Namibia and to the representative of Madagascar and extended additional invitations, at their request, to the representatives of Algeria, Cuba, Democratic Kampuchea, Egypt, Ghana, Guinea, Kenya, Malawi, Mauritius, Morocco, Mozambique, Nigeria, Saudi Arabia, Sierra Leone, the Yemen Arab Republic, Yugoslavia and Zambia to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

In accordance with the request contained in a letter dated 27 September 1976 from Benin, the Libyan Arab Republic and the United Republic of Tanzania (S/12205), the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation to Mr. Sam Nujoma under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure.
