NOTE VERBALE DATED 26 JULY 1978 FROM THE DEPUTY PERMANENT
REPRESENTATIVE OF ARGENTINA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Deputy Permanent Representative of the Argentine Republic to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to refer to his note PO 230 SOAF (2-2-5) of 18 May 1978 concerning the implementation of the provisions of Security Council resolution 418 (1977).

In this connexion, the Government of Argentina wishes to reaffirm the statement in the communication transmitted on 30 January 1978 to the President of the Security Council (S/12551) and accordingly to reiterate that it has no contractual arrangements with South Africa for the supply of arms nor has it granted that country licences for the manufacture and maintenance of arms, munitions of any type, equipment or military vehicles.
