LETTER DATED 10 APRIL 1979 FROM THE PERMANENT OBSERVER OF THE
PALESTINE LIBERATION ORGANIZATION TO THE UNITED NATIONS
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Upon instructions of the Executive Committee of the Palestine Liberation Organization, I wish to call to your attention the latest series of Israeli violations.

This afternoon, the Israeli Air Force carried out severe raids on the towns of Damour and Tyre, killing three children and a woman, and wounding three men in Damour, and killing one civilian and wounding four others in Tyre. Several houses were destroyed during the raids.

Last night, Israeli naval forces attempted to make a landing near Rashidiyeh Camp, but met with resistance from our fighters, who prevented them from landing.

I am instructed to call on you to take immediate and effective measures to put an end to this series of provocations and violations, which will inevitably lead to escalation and aggravate the already explosive situation, constituting a real threat to peace and international security.
