NOTE VERBALE DATED 25 MAY 1978 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF CHILE  
TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of Chile to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, in reply to his note of 10 November 1977, in which he brought to the notice of the Government of Chile the text of Security Council resolution 418 (1977), has the honour to inform him that the Government of Chile supports the provisions of that Security Council resolution and will comply with it. The Government of Chile also takes this opportunity to reaffirm its condemnation of the policy of apartheid and of every other policy of racial discrimination, in whatever country it may be applied. The Government of Chile likewise supports the efforts of the United Nations and the international community to secure the elimination of such policies.

The Permanent Mission of Chile requests that this note verbale be distributed as a document of the Security Council.
