LETTER DATED 12 APRIL 1976 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF MOZAMBIQUE TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On the instructions of my Government I have the honour to request that in connexion with the Security Council consideration of the situation obtaining in East Timor, the Council extend an invitation, under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure, to His Excellency Ken Fry, member of the House of Representatives of the Australian Commonwealth Parliament, in order to supply the Council with information related to the question under discussion.
