LETTER DATED 13 AUGUST 1976 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF TURKEY TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to bring to your attention a list of illustrative nature of the harrassment and intimidation actions by the vessels and aircraft belonging to the Greek Navy and Air Force against the Turkish research vessel, SISMIK-I.

I would also like to point out that SISMIK-I is an unarmed civilian vessel carrying out research.

It is therefore obvious that the irresponsible Greek provocations are totally groundless and devoid of any justification.

I would be grateful if the said list were published as a document of the Security Council.
