REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON THE ADMISSION OF NEW  
MEMBERS CONCERNING THE APPLICATION OF WESTERN  
SAMOA FOR MEMBERSHIP IN THE UNITED NATIONS

1. At the 1976th meeting on 1 December 1976, the Security Council had before it the application of Western Samoa (S/12245) for admission to membership in the United Nations. In accordance with rule 59 of the provisional rules of procedure and in the absence of any objection, the President of the Security Council referred the application to the Committee for examination and report.

2. At its 59th meeting, held on 1 December 1976, the Committee considered the application of Western Samoa and unanimously decided to recommend to the Security Council the adoption of the following draft resolution:

The Security Council,

Having examined the application of Western Samoa for admission to the United Nations (S/12245),

Recommends to the General Assembly that Western Samoa be admitted to membership in the United Nations.

3. The Committee further decided to recommend to the Security Council that it should have recourse to the provisions of the last paragraph of rule 60 of the provisional rules of procedure.
