PROGRAMME OF ACTION FOR THE PREVENTION OF THE SALE OF CHILDREN, CHILD PROSTITUTION AND CHILD PORNOGRAPHY

Note by the secretariat

- 1. In its resolution 1992/2, the Sub-Commission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities requested the Secretary-General, pursuant to Commission on Human Rights resolution 1992/74 of 5 March 1992, to invite all States to inform the Sub-Commission of measures adopted to implement the Programme of Action for the Prevention of the Sale of Children, Child Prostitution and Child Pornography, contained in the annex to resolution 1992/74.
- 2. The Sub-Commission also requested the Working Group to examine the state of the implementation of the Programme of Action at its eighteenth session and to transmit, through the Sub-Commission, a report thereon to the Commission at its fiftieth session. In accordance with the above requests, the Secretary-General sent a note verbale to all States on 6 November 1992 and prepared a report (E/CN/4/Sub.2/AC.2/1993/8). In its resolution 1993/5, the Sub-Commission decided to transmit the report to the Commission on Human Rights. The attention of the Commission is therefore drawn to documents E/CN.4/Sub.2/1993/31 and Add.1.
