## Paragraph 5.1., amend to read:

" . . .

(d) Brake linings shall not contain asbestos."

### Insert a new paragraph 12, to read:

- "12. TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS
- 12.1. No Contracting Party shall refuse to grant approvals under this Regulation as amended by the 01 series of amendments.
- 12.2. As from 1 January 1995 Contracting Parties applying this Regulation shall grant approvals only if the replacement brake lining assembly approved meets the requirements of this Regulation as amended by the 01 series of amendments.
- 12.3. Contracting Parties applying this Regulation shall continue to allow fitting or use on a vehicle in use of a replacement brake lining assembly approved to this Regulation in its original, unamended form."
