> REPORT OF THE SUB-COMMISSION ON PREVENTION OF DISCRIMINATION AND PROTECTION OF MINORITIES ON ITS FORTY-SEVENTH SESSION

Note by the Secretariat transmitting the final draft programme of action for the prevention of traffic in persons and the exploitation of the prostitution of others

1. In its resolution 1995/27 of 3 March 1995, the Commission on Human Rights requested the Sub-Commission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities to review, at its forty-seventh session, the draft programme of action for the prevention of traffic in persons and the exploitation of the prostitution of others (E/CN.4/Sub.2/1991/41, annex I). At its forty-seventh session, the Sub-Commission reviewed the draft programme of action in the light of the comments submitted, and recommended, in its resolution 1995/16 of 18 August 1995, that the Commission on Human Rights adopt the final draft programme of action contained in document E/CN.4/Sub.2/1995/28/Add.1.

2. Pursuant to the above-mentioned resolutions, the Commission on Human Rights will have before it, at its present session, for its approval, the final draft programme of action for the prevention of traffic in persons and the exploitation of the prostitution of others.
