The Permanent Mission of Saint Kitts and Nevis to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to transmit for his attention its Government's position with regard to Security Council resolution 1054 (1996) of 25 April 1996.

The Permanent Mission has the further honour to advise that the Government of Saint Kitts and Nevis expresses its compliance with the resolution and in particular with the stipulations outlined in paragraph 3 (b), and that immigration officials have been notified that access to Saint Kitts and Nevis shall be denied to "members of the Government of Sudan, officials of that Government and members of the Sudanese armed forces".
