1. At its 44th meeting, on 15 December 1996, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the note by the Secretariat on meetings additional to the approved calendar of conferences and meetings for the biennium 1996-1997 (A/C.5/51/22 and Add.1 and 2).

2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/51/SR.44).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the relevant draft resolutions contained in the reports of the Sixth Committee on agenda items 144, Convention on the law of the non-navigational uses of international watercourses; 147, Establishment of an international criminal court; 150, Report of the Special Committee on the Charter of the United Nations and on the Strengthening of the Role of the Organization; and 151, Measures to eliminate international terrorism, the question of the additional meetings requested in connection with those resolutions would be dealt with by the Fifth Committee in the context of its draft resolution on agenda item 118, Pattern of conferences.
