LETTER DATED 23 DECEMBER 1996 FROM THE PRESIDENT OF THE
SECURITY COUNCIL ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to inform you that your letter to me of 16 December 1996 enclosing a letter from the Permanent Representative of Canada dated 13 December 1996 (S/1996/1046), which recommends the termination of the mandate of the multinational force established by the Security Council in its resolution 1080 (1996), has been brought to the attention of the members of the Council.

The members of the Security Council take note of the view of the Government of Canada expressed in the letter of 13 December 1996 and they agree that the functions of the multinational force have therefore come to an end.

The Security Council remains actively seized of the matter, and would welcome periodic reports on the situation on the Great Lakes region.
