5. At the 16th meeting, on 28 October, the representative of Poland, on behalf of Argentina, Austria, Belarus, Cambodia, Croatia, Georgia, Guatemala, Honduras, Hungary, Italy, Malaysia, Morocco, the Philippines, Poland, the Republic of Korea, Romania, Slovenia, Sweden, Turkey and Ukraine introduced a draft resolution entitled "Question of the elaboration of an international convention against organized transnational crime" (A/C.3/51/L.10). Subsequently, Belgium, Cape Verde, the Czech Republic, France, Ireland, Lithuania, Norway, Portugal, Sierra Leone, Slovakia, Spain, The former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, the United States of America and Uruguay joined in sponsoring the draft resolution.
