SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS  
OF WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE  
STAGE REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3701st meeting, held on 10 October 1996, in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Bosnia and Herzegovina, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President stated that, following consultations of the Council, he had been authorized to make a statement on behalf of the Council and read out the text of that statement (for the text, see S/PRST/1996/41; to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-first Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1996).

By a letter dated 7 October 1996 addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/1996/832), the Permanent Representative of Zimbabwe to the United Nations, on behalf of the five States Members of the United Nations, namely Angola, Botswana, Mozambique, South Africa and Zimbabwe, selected by the summit meeting of the Southern African Development Community (SADC) in Luanda to proceed to New York in order to participate in the debate on the peace process in Angola, requested that a meeting of the Security Council be convened on Thursday, 10 October 1996, to consider the critical situation in Angola.

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3702nd meeting, held on 10 October 1996, in response to the above request, also having before it the progress report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Angola Verification Mission (UNAVEM III) (S/1996/827).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Algeria, Angola, Brazil, Burundi, Cape Verde, Costa Rica, Cuba, India, Ireland, Lesotho, Malawi, Malaysia, Mali, Mozambique, Nicaragua, Nigeria, Portugal, Tunisia, Zambia and Zimbabwe, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The Security Council continued its consideration of the item at its 3703rd meeting, held on 11 October 1996.

The President drew attention to the text of a draft resolution (S/1996/844) which had been prepared in the course of the Council's prior consultations.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/1996/844 and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1075 (1996) (for the text, see S/RES/1075 (1996); to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-first Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1996).
