559 (XVIII). Application from the People's Republic of Bulgaria for membership in the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization

The Economic and Social Council,

Having considered the application for the admission of the People's Republic of Bulgaria to the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization, transmitted by that Organization to the Council in accordance with article II of the Agreement between the United Nations and the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization,

Decides to inform the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization that it has no objection to the admission of the People's Republic of Bulgaria to that Organization.

Application from the People's Republic of Albania for membership in the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization

At its 831st meeting, on 5 November 1954, the Council decided to include the above item as a supplementary item in the agenda of its eighteenth session.

At its 832nd meeting, on 23 November 1954, the Council rejected a proposal² according to which it would have informed UNESCO that it had no objection to the admission of the People's Republic of Albania to that Organization.

Transmission of General Assembly resolution 837 (IX) to the Commission on Human Rights

At its 834th meeting, on 16 December 1954, the Council decided to transmit to the Commission on Human Rights General Assembly resolution 837 (IX) on recommendations concerning international respect for the right of peoples and nations to self-determination.

Basic programme of the Council for 1955

At its 833rd and 834th meetings on 16 December 1954, the Council worked out its basic programme for 1955³ and considered the provisional agenda for its nineteenth session drawn up by the Secretary-General. At its 834th meeting, it decided to request the Secretariat, after consultation with members of the Council and specialized agencies, to establish the dates for opening debate on items allocated to the nineteenth session.
