SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF
WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE
REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in documents S/1996/15 of 11 January 1996, S/1996/15/Add.4 of 9 February 1996, S/1996/15/Add.8 of 8 March 1996, S/1996/15/Add.14 of 19 April 1996, S/1996/15/Add.18 of 17 May 1996, S/1996/15/Add.32 of 23 August 1996, S/1996/15/Add.41 of 25 October 1996 and S/1996/15/Add.43 of 8 November 1996.

During the week ending 7 December 1996, the Security Council took action on the following items:

The situation in Sierra Leone (see S/1995/40/Add.47, S/1996/15/Add.6 and S/1996/15/Add.11)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3720th meeting, held on 4 December 1996, in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Sierra Leone, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President stated that, following consultations of the Council, he had been authorized to make a statement on behalf of the Council. He then read out the text of that statement (for the text, see S/PRST/1996/46; to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-first Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1996).

The question concerning Haiti (see S/25070/Add.24 and Corr.1, S/25070/Add.34, S/25070/Add.35, S/25070/Add.37, S/25070/Add.38, S/25070/Add.41, S/25070/Add.43, S/25070/Add.46, S/1994/20/Add.1, S/1994/20/Add.11, S/1994/20/Add.17,

S/1994/20/Add.25, S/1994/20/Add.27, S/1994/20/Add.30, S/1994/20/Add.38, S/1994/20/Add.40, S/1994/20/Add.47, S/1995/40/Add.4, S/1995/40/Add.16, S/1995/40/Add.30, S/1995/40/Add.45, S/1996/15/Add.8, S/1996/15/Add.25 and S/1996/15/Add.47; see also S/22110/Add.39)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3721st meeting, held on 5 December 1996, in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Support Mission in Haiti (S/1996/813 and Add.1).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Argentina, Canada, Haiti and Venezuela, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to the text of a draft resolution (S/1996/1002) which had been submitted by Argentina, Canada, Chile, France, the United States of America and Venezuela.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/1996/1002 and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1086 (1996) (for the text, see S/RES/1086 (1996); to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-first Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1996).
