> REVIEW OF THE EFFICIENCY OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE AND FINANCIAL FUNCTIONING OF THE UNITED NATIONS

> > Report of the Fifth Committee

I. INTRODUCTION

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 20 September 1996, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its fifty-first session the item entitled "Review of the efficiency of the administrative and financial functioning of the United Nations" and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.

2. The Fifth Committee considered the item at its 12th, 15th, 42nd, 43rd, 46th and 47th meetings, on 23 and 29 October and 12, 13, 17 and 18 December 1996. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/51/SR.12, 15, 42, 43, 46 and 47).

II. CONSIDERATION OF PROPOSALS

A. Draft decision A/C.5/51/L.28

3. At its 47th meeting, on 18 December, the Committee had before it a draft decision entitled "Action taken on certain items" (A/C.5/51/L.28), which had been submitted by the Chairman.

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4. At the same meeting, the Secretary of the Committee made a statement and orally amended the draft decision by deleting items 121, United Nations common system, and 122, United Nations pension system.

5. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft decision A/C.5/51/L.28, as orally amended, without a vote (see para. 9, draft decision I).

B. Draft decision A/C.5/51/L.29

6. At its 47th meeting, on 18 December, the Committee had before it a draft decision entitled "Biennial programme of work of the Fifth Committee for 1997-1998" (A/C.5/51/L.29), which had been submitted by the Chairman.

7. At the same meeting, the Secretary of the Committee made a statement and orally amended the annex to the draft decision by inserting a new item in section A, after item 11, and in section B, after item 14, reading:

"Report of the Secretary-General on the activities of the Office of Internal Oversight Services"

and renumbering the subsequent items accordingly.

8. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft decision A/C.5/51/L.29, as orally amended, without a vote (see para. 9, draft decision II).
