Subject: PENSIONABLE REMUNERATION FOR STAFF IN THE PROFESSIONAL CATEGORY AND ABOVE AND FOR STAFF IN THE FIELD SERVICE CATEGORY*

1. It will be recalled that, by its resolution 48/225 of 23 December 1993, the General Assembly requested the International Civil Service Commission (ICSC), in close cooperation with the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Board and as part of the comprehensive review in 1996 of the methodology, to determine the pensionable remuneration and consequent pensions of staff in the Professional category and above, to develop a common staff assessment scale for the determination of the pensionable remuneration of all categories of staff using the approved procedure and reflecting the latest available tax rates.

2. ICSC, in its twenty-second annual report,¹ decided to recommend to the General Assembly a common scale of staff assessment in determining the pensionable remuneration for all categories of staff. This was subsequently approved by the General Assembly in its resolution 51/216, section III, of 18 December 1996, with effect from 1 January 1997.

3. The current procedure for adjusting the scale of pensionable remuneration for staff in the Professional category and above provides for this scale to be revised on the same date as the net remuneration amounts (base salary plus post adjustment) of staff in the Professional category and above in New York are adjusted. The scale of pensionable remuneration for the above-mentioned categories, in accordance with the provisions of article 54 (b) of the Regulations of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund, must be adjusted with the same effective date and by the same percentage as the net remuneration increase.

4. In accordance with the procedure described in paragraph 3 above, the Chairman of ICSC has promulgated the consequent new scale of pensionable remuneration applicable to staff in the Professional category and above, effective 1 January 1997, taking into account the consolidation, on a no-gain no-loss basis, of 5.26 multiplier points into net base salaries in effect under the previous base salary scale, which became effective 1 March 1995 and the additional increase of 0.4 per cent in base pay (as announced in information circular ST/IC/1997/2 dated 7 January 1997) and the new common staff assessment scale. The revised scale is reproduced in annex I to the present circular.

5. Following the same procedure mentioned above, the pensionable remuneration amounts for staff in the Field Service category will also be revised effective 1 January 1997. The revised scale is set out in annex II to the present circular.

6. The January 1997 statements of earnings and deductions will reflect the changes in the monthly pension contributions resulting from the revised scales of pensionable remuneration contained in annexes I and II to the present circular.
