INTRODUCTORY NOTE

For over 25 years the United Nations has been seized with the problem of the racial policies of the government of the Republic of South Africa. From the Sharpeville incident in 1960 to the Soweto riots in 1976, the United Nations has deliberated this issue in the General Assembly as well as the Security Council. During its thirty-second session, the General Assembly proclaimed the year beginning on 21 March 1978 as International Anti-Apartheid Year and invited the Special Committee against Apartheid to promote the world wide observance of the Year in full solidarity with the oppressed people of South Africa.

In conjunction with the observance of International Anti-Apartheid Year, the Dag Hammarskjöld Library, at the request of the Centre on Apartheid has prepared this special bibliography. It is a supplement to the bibliography published in 1970^{1/} and includes all references contained in the 1974 supplement^{2/}. It is a select bibliography in so far as its contents are limited to material available in the Dag Hammarskjöld Library and published in the period 1970-1978. References to United Nations publications are in English only; many of these documents, however, are available in some of the official languages of the Organisation.

It is hoped that this bibliography will be useful to all those who are engaged in finding a solution to this problem.

NOTE LIMINAIRE

Depuis plus de 25 ans, l'Organisation des Nations Unies est saisie du problème des politiques raciales du Gouvernement de la République sud-africaine. De l'incident de Sharpeville en 1960 aux émeutes de Soweto en 1976, l'ONU a examiné ce problème dans le cadre de l'Assemblée générale et du Conseil de sécurité. Au cours de sa trente-deuxième session, l'Assemblée générale a proclamé commençant le 21 mars 1978 une Année internationale pour la lutte contre l'apartheid et a invité le Comité spécial contre l'apartheid favoriser l'observation de cette Année dans le monde entier, en totale solidarité avec le peuple opprimé d'Afrique du Sud.

Dans le cadre de la célébration de l'Année internationale pour la lutte contre l'apartheid, la Bibliothèque Dag Hammarskjöld a préparé, à la demande du Centre contre l'apartheid, la bibliographie spéciale ci-jointe. Elle constitue un supplément à la bibliographie publiée en 1970^{1/} et comprend toutes les références contenues dans le Supplément de 1974^{2/}. Une bibliographie choisie, car son contenu est limité aux ouvrages disponibles à la Bibliothèque Dag Hammarskjöld et publiés entre 1970 et 1978. Les références aux publications des Nations Unies sont uniquement en anglais; toutefois, un grand nombre de ces documents existent également dans certaines des langues officielles de l'Organisation.

Cette bibliographie devrait être utile à tous ceux qui cherchent une solution à ce problème.
