2. <u>Election of the President of the session</u>

Rule 10 of the rules of procedure provides for the election by the Committee of the President at the beginning of the session. Rule 40 provides that all elections shall be held by secret ballot unless the Committee decides otherwise in an election in which the number of candidates does not exceed the number of elective places to be filled.

3. Election of officers other than the President

Rule 10 of the rules of procedure of the Committee provides that, in addition to the President, the Committee shall elect three vice-presidents and a rapporteur, and rule 40 provides that all elections shall be held by secret ballot unless the Committee decides otherwise in an election in which the number of candidates does not exceed the number of elective places to be filled.

4. Adoption of the agenda and organization of work

The Committee may wish to adopt its agenda on the basis of the provisional agenda approved at its ninth session.

The Committee may further wish to decide on its organization of work on the basis of suggestions by the secretariat.

5. <u>Review of progress made in implementing the Buenos Aires Plan of Action,</u> <u>the decisions of the High-level Committee and the recommendations of the</u> <u>South Commission</u>

In accordance with recommendations 37 (a), (b) and (c) of the Buenos Aires Plan of Action for Promoting and Implementing Technical Cooperation among Developing Countries, as endorsed by the General Assembly in its resolution 33/134 of 19 December 1978, and with Committee decision 9/1 (paras. 2, 3, 6, 7 and 8), the Administrator of the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) will submit to the Committee a report on the progress made in implementing the tasks entrusted to the United Nations development system by the Buenos Aires Plan of Action as well as by the recommendations of the South Commission. The report, prepared by the Special Unit for Technical Cooperation among Developing Countries, provides an assessment of progress made in the implementation of technical cooperation among developing countries on the basis of the biennial progress reports submitted by the organizations of the United Nations development system and the responses of some Governments of both developed and developing countries, as well as intergovernmental organizations, on their activities to support and promote technical cooperation among developing countries. That report is prepared in response to paragraph 10 of Committee decision 7/5 concerning the submission to Committee sessions of a single document containing an analysis of the information provided by Governments and organizations with conclusions and recommendations as appropriate.

In accordance with paragraph 9 of Committee decision 9/2, the Administrator will present to the Committee a progress report on implementation of the new directions strategy.
