FOLLOW-UP TO THE FOURTH WORLD CONFERENCE ON WOMEN

Draft decision submitted by the Chairperson

The Commission on the Status of Women recommends the following decision for adoption by the Economic and Social Council:

Functional commissions

The Economic and Social Council, bearing in mind the Programme of Action adopted by the World Conference on Human Rights,¹ the Programme of Action of the World Summit for Social Development² and the Beijing Platform for Action,³ and recalling General Assembly resolutions 50/227, 51/96, 51/118 and 51/202 dealing with the implementation of the outcome of United Nations conferences and the role of the functional commissions in the three-tiered intergovernmental process in the follow-up to the above-mentioned programmes of action, decides that every effort should be made to ensure that there is no overlap between the sessions of the functional commissions engaged in the follow-up to United Nations conferences.
