IDENTICAL LETTERS DATED 24 MARCH 1997 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I. OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF ISRAEL TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL AND TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL
