### ELECTIONS, NOMINATIONS AND APPOINTMENTS

## Election of 13 members of the Intergovernmental Working Group of Experts on International Standards of Accounting and Reporting

### Note by the Secretary-General

1. The Intergovernmental Working Group of Experts on International Standards of Accounting and Reporting has 34 members. In accordance with resolutions 1982/67 and 1985/71, the Economic and Social Council is to elect, at its resumed organizational session for 1997, 10 members of the Working Group for a threeyear term beginning on 1 January 1998 to fill the vacancies that will occur on 31 December 1997 upon the expiration of the terms of the following members: Chile, Cyprus, Hungary, India, Jordan, Nigeria, Pakistan, Romania, Sudan and Swaziland. The Council is also to elect, for the same term, three members to fill vacancies not previously filled by the Council: one member from African States and two members from Latin American and Caribbean States.

- 2. The members are to be elected according to the following pattern:
  - (a) Four members from African States;
  - (b) Four members from Asian States;
  - (c) Two members from Eastern European States;
  - (d) Three members from Latin American and Caribbean States.

3. In addition, the Council is to elect one member from African States, two members from Asian States, two members from Latin American and Caribbean States and three members from Western European and other States for a term beginning on the date of election and expiring on 31 December 1999, and one member from African States and two members from Latin American and Caribbean States for a term beginning on the date of election and expiring on 31 December 1997. These elections were postponed from a previous session.

4. The composition of the Working Group in 1997 is given in the annex below.
