REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON RELATIONS WITH THE HOST COUNTRY

Letter dated 11 April 1997 from the Chairman of the Committee  
on Relations with the Host Country addressed to the President  
of the General Assembly

I have the honour to inform you that the Committee on Relations with the Host Country adopted, at its 185th meeting, held on 10 April 1997, the following recommendation:

"The Committee recommends that the General Assembly resume as a matter of urgency, consideration of its agenda item on the report of the Committee on Relations with the Host Country in order to examine questions relating to the parking of diplomatic vehicles. It is understood that, if the host country is in a position to indicate in the coming week that the implementation of the elements of the Programme which according to the legal opinion of the Legal Counsel appear not to be in full compliance with international law has been deferred, the Assembly's consideration of the matter will also be deferred."

I should appreciate it if you would bring the present letter to the attention of the General Assembly for appropriate action.<sup>1</sup>

I will inform you of further developments pertinent to this matter as soon as additional information is available to me.
