LETTER DATED 9 APRIL 1997 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF IRAO TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you that 3,863 bombs, missiles and other ordnance left behind by the 1991 30-Power aggression against Iraq were found and disposed of in all parts of the country between 1 February and 31 March 1997. The items included American-made cluster bombs as well as spherical bombs, strip bombs, spindle bombs and air-launched dispensers.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
