LETTER DATED 3 SEPTEMBER 1981 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF BANGLADESH TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to forward herewith text of a message from His Excellency Professor Muhammad Shamsul Huq, Foreign Minister of Bangladesh, addressed to Your Excellency:

"Bangladesh along with the entire civilised world community is shocked at the naked aggression committed by the racist Pretorian régime of South Africa on Angola. The continuing acts of aggression by the same régime on Angolan territory pose a serious threat to peace and stability in that region. The Government of Bangladesh strongly urges your Excellency and the Security Council to take urgent and effective action to stop and terminate this barbarous attack on Angolan territory. We assure Your Excellency our full cooperation and support in your efforts.
