LETTER DATED 10 APRIL 1997 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 1100 (1997) of 27 March 1997, by which the Council decided to extend the mandate of the United Nations Military Observer Mission in Liberia (UNOMIL) until 30 June 1997.

I should like to inform the Council that Mr. Anthony B. Nyakyi (United Republic of Tanzania), who has been serving as my Special Representative for Liberia since 11 December 1994, will be completing his assignment on 15 April 1997. Mr. Nyakyi has performed his duties with professionalism and distinction and has made an important contribution to the cause of peace in Liberia, often under difficult circumstances.

Following the usual consultations, it is my intention to appoint Mr. Tuliameni Kalomoh, who is currently serving as Permanent Secretary in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Namibia, to succeed Mr. Nyakyi as my Special Representative for Liberia.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
