Subject: TAKE OUR DAUGHTERS TO WORK DAY - 24 APRIL 1997

1. On Thursday, 24 April 1997, the United Nations, the United Nations Children's Fund, the United Nations Development Programme, the United Nations Development Fund for Women, the United Nations Population Fund, the United Nations Staff Committee and the Group on Equal Rights for Women will jointly celebrate Take Our Daughters to Work Day from 9.30 a.m. to 12 noon in the General Assembly Hall.

2. Registration will begin at 9.30 a.m. outside the General Assembly Hall. Activities are planned throughout the morning. The Secretary-General has agreed to address those daughters participating in the event. There are specialized tours organized for girls aged 9 to 12 and small group discussions for girls aged 13 to 15. Parents are requested to pick up their daughters at the General Assembly Hall at 12 noon. It is suggested that they spend the rest of the afternoon with their parents/mentors observing and participating in their work environment.

3. Bearing in mind the importance of this day for our daughters, who will become the managers and decision makers of the future, supervisors are encouraged to exercise maximum flexibility to allow for the greatest staff participation possible.
