1. <u>Election of officers</u>

In accordance with rule 80 of the rules of procedure of the Economic and Social Council, the Committee will elect its officers.

2. Adoption of the agenda and other organizational matters

The provisional agenda and documentation for the present session of the Committee were approved by the Economic and Social Council in its decision 1995/306.

- 3. <u>Applications for consultative status and requests for reclassification</u> received from non-governmental organizations

The Committee will consider applications for consultative status and requests for reclassification from non-governmental organizations and act thereon. The Committee will also consider applications that were deferred by the Committee at its 1996 session.

4. <u>Review of quadrennial reports submitted by non-governmental organizations</u> <u>in consultative status with the Economic and Social Council, general and</u> <u>special categories</u>

In accordance with the arrangements for consultation with non-governmental organizations approved by the Economic and Social Council in its resolution 1996/31, such organizations are required to submit, every fourth year, a report on their activities as regards the support they have given to the work of the United Nations. The Committee, at its regular session in 1981, decided that such reports should be limited to two pages. After examining those reports, the Committee may recommend to the Council any reclassification in the status of the organizations concerned that it deems appropriate.

5. Implementation of Economic and Social Council decision 1996/302
