SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS  
OF WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE  
STAGE REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in document S/1997/40 of 10 January 1997.

During the week ending 15 March 1997, the Security Council took action on the following items:

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3749th meeting, held on 11 March 1997 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it two letters dated 7 March 1997 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/1997/201 and S/1997/204).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Bosnia and Herzegovina, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President stated that, following consultations of the Council, he had been authorized to make a statement on behalf of the Council and read out the text of that statement (for the text, see S/PRST/1997/12; to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-second Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1997).

Security of United Nations operations (see S/25070/Add.39; see also S/25070/Add.13)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3750th meeting, held on 12 March 1997 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

The President stated that, following consultations of the Council, he had been authorized to make a statement on behalf of the Council and read out the text of that statement (for the text, see S/PRST/1997/13; to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-second Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1997).

#### The situation in Albania

By a letter dated 12 March 1997 addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/1997/214), the Permanent Representative of Italy to the United Nations requested, in accordance with Article 35 of the Charter of the United Nations, the convening of an urgent meeting of the Security Council to consider the situation in Albania.

By a letter dated 13 March 1997 addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/1997/215), the Permanent Representative of Albania to the United Nations requested, in accordance with Article 35 of the Charter of the United Nations, the convening of an urgent meeting of the Security Council to consider the situation in Albania.

The Security Council met to consider the item at its 3751st meeting, held on 13 March 1997 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the above requests.

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Albania and Italy, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President stated that, following consultations of the Council, he had been authorized to make a statement on behalf of the Council and read out the text of that statement (for the text, see S/PRST/1997/14; to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-second Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1997).

The situation in Tajikistan and along the Tajik-Afghan border (see S/25070/Add.34; S/1994/20/Add.37, 44 and 49; S/1995/40/Add.14, 19, 23, 33, 44 and 49; S/1996/15/Add.20, 23, 37 and 49; and S/1997/40/Add.5; see also S/23370/Add.43)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3752nd meeting, held on 14 March 1997 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General on the situation in Tajikistan (S/1997/198).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Tajikistan, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to the text of a draft resolution (S/1997/216), which had been prepared in the course of the Council's prior consultations.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/1997/216, and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1099 (1997) (for the text, see S/RES/1099 (1997); to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-second Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1997).
