to the President of the General Assembly

Further to my letters dated 21 and 30 January, 4, 12 and 21 March and 18 April 1997 (A/51/780 and Add.1 to 5), I have the honour to inform you that Burundi,¹ Cape Verde, the Dominican Republic, Georgia, Guatemala,¹ Guinea, Haiti,¹ Madagascar, Mauritania¹ and Saint Vincent and the Grenadines have made the necessary payments to reduce their arrears below the amount specified in Article 19 of the Charter.
