Letter dated 20 May 1997 from Mr. Osman Ertuğ addressed to  
the Secretary-General

Further to my letter dated 13 May 1997 addressed to you, I have the honour to bring to your attention new evidence regarding the utilization and apparent expropriation of Turkish Cypriot-owned properties in the south by the Greek Cypriot authorities.

At a press conference he held on 16 May 1997, the Greek Cypriot Interior Minister, Mr. Dinos Michaelides, disclosed that "over 4,000 Greek Cypriot refugees would be given ownership titles" for plots on which they have built homes (The Cyprus Mail, 17 May 1997). Although the plots in question are claimed to be on "state-owned land", the Greek Cypriot official admitted that "there were several problems with these homes ... Problems included the use of Turkish Cypriot homes ...".

The above information speaks for itself and confirms the utilization and even expropriation of Turkish Cypriot properties in the south by the Greek Cypriot administration. It also shows the hypocrisy behind the Greek Cypriot side's complaints that the Turkish Cypriot side is utilizing abandoned property in the north.

I should be grateful if the text of the present letter could be circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under agenda item 58, and of the Security Council.
