Declaration issued on 5 June 1997 by the Presidency of the
European Union on the signature of the Russian-Ukrainian
political treaty

The European Union welcomes the signing of the political treaty between the Russian Federation and Ukraine by President Yeltsin and President Kuchma at Kiev on 31 May 1997.

The Union is aware of the efforts undertaken by both countries to reach agreement on the numerous bilateral issues. The agreement testifies to the statesmanship of both presidents and Governments.

The Union considers this agreement an important step towards peace and stability on the European continent.

The Central and Eastern European countries associated with the European Union, Cyprus, Iceland and Norway align themselves with the present declaration.
