Statement issued on 2 June 1997 by the European Union on the
accession of Cambodia, the Lao People's Democratic Republic
and Myanmar to the Association of South-East Asian Nations

The European Union (EU) notes that the Foreign Ministers of the Association of South-East Asian Nations (ASEAN) have decided to accept Cambodia, the Lao People's Democratic Republic and Myanmar as full ASEAN members on the occasion of the forthcoming ASEAN ministerial meeting in July in Kuala Lumpur.

The Union looks forward to continued close cooperation between our two respective regions. On the occasion of this anniversary, EU wishes to reaffirm its commitment to the EU-ASEAN dialogue and to the promotion of shared values, including respect for human rights and democratic principles. It trusts that membership of ASEAN will further these aims in the new member States and in particular in Myanmar, where the situation in this regard continues to be of serious concern to the international community.
