- C. Implementation in areas requiring urgent action
  - 3. Means of implementation
- 1. The Ad Hoc Committee of the Whole considered paragraphs 105 to 107 of the proposed outcome of the special session (A/S-19/14-E/1997/60, chap. I.B) at its \_\_th meeting, on \_\_ June 1997.
- 2. At the same meeting, the Committee approved the following amendments and recommended those paragraphs to the General Assembly for adoption, as amended:
  - (a) Paragraph 105 was revised to read:
    - "105. The Commission's work programme on indicators for sustainable development should result in a practicable and agreed set of indicators, suited to country-specific conditions, including a limited number of aggregated indicators, to be used at the national level, on a voluntary basis, by the year 2000. Such indicators of sustainable development, including, where appropriate, and subject to nationally specific conditions, sector-specific ones, should play an important role in monitoring progress towards sustainable development at the national level and in facilitating national reporting, as appropriate";

- (b) Paragraph 106 was deleted.
- (c) Paragraph 107 was revised to read:

"107. National reports on the implementation of Agenda 21 have proved to be a valuable means of sharing information at the international and regional levels and, even more important, of providing a focus for the coordination of issues related to sustainable development at the national level within individual countries. National reporting should continue (see also paragraph 125 (b) and (c))".
